A Lasting Legacy

Scholarship-seeking season comes to an end on January 31 when the Legacy Award application closes. Legacy Awards are available to high school seniors who are the children and/or grandchildren of dues-paying Elks who joined the Order on or before April 1, 2017, or are charter members of a Lodge that was instituted on or after April 1, 2017.

Each Legacy Awards recipient will receive a \$4,000 scholarship distributed over the course of their college career.

"This award means so much to me because I've seen how much my grandparents enjoy being Elks, and I look forward to getting involved," says Erin Murphy, a 2019 Legacy scholar sponsored by Inverness, Fla., Lodge No. 2522.

Legacy Awards scholars are required to serve with the Elks once per year. 
